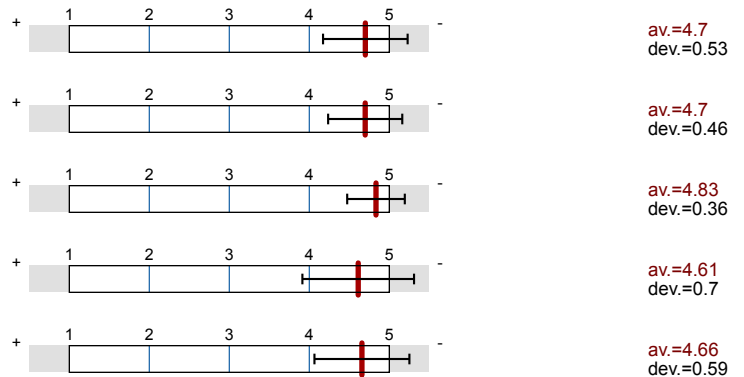

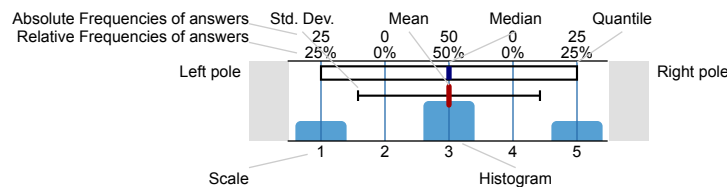

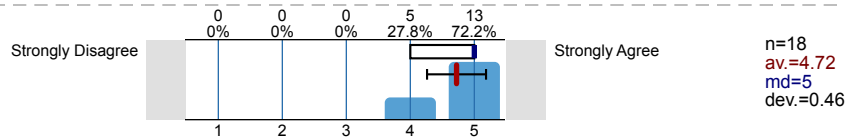
The course challenged me to think deeply about the subject matter.



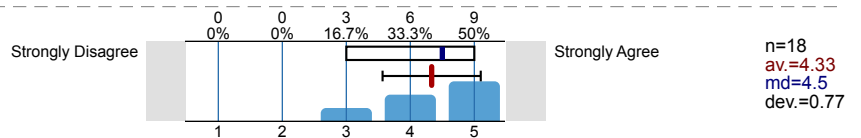
The instructor clearly communicated what was expected of me in this class.



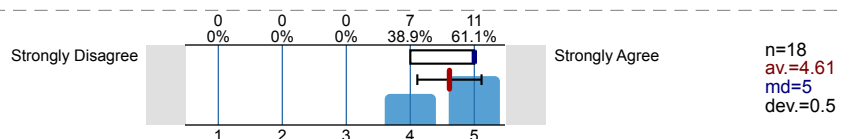

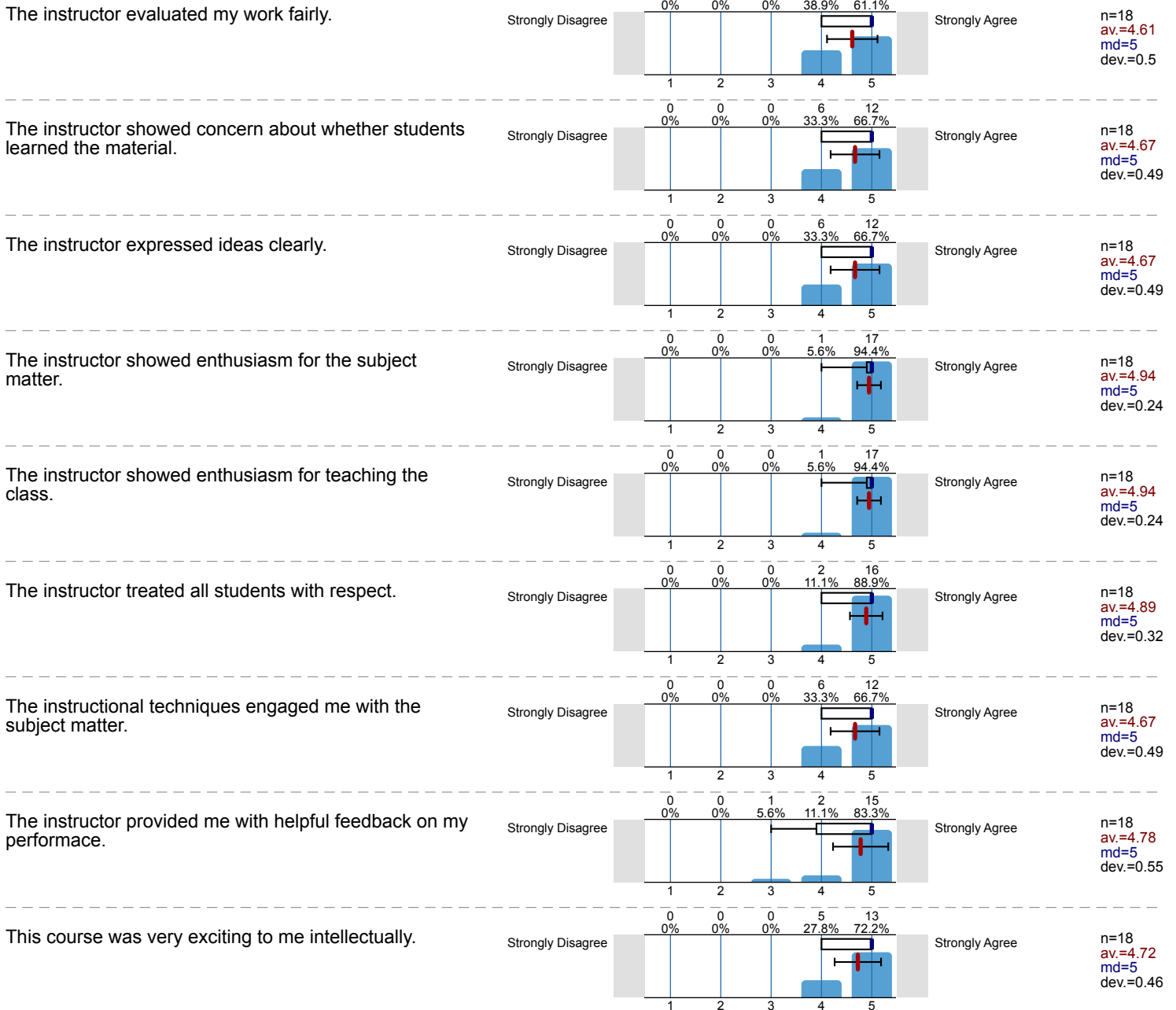


The course material (e.g., coursepack, website, texts) helped me better understand the subject matter.

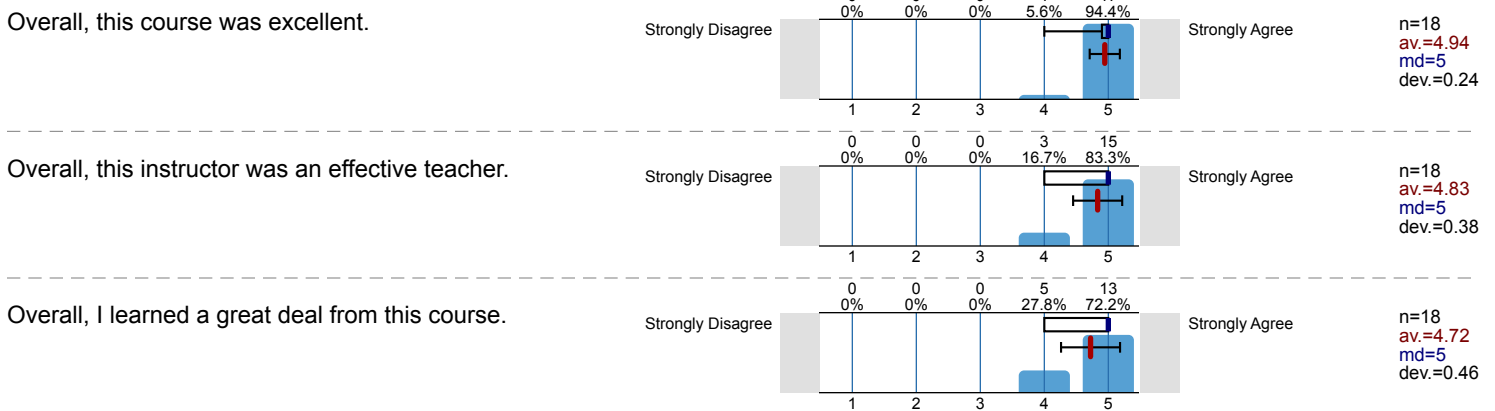


The course assignments helped me better understand the subject matter.

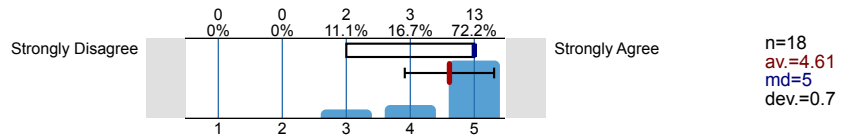


Comments on overall assessment of this course.

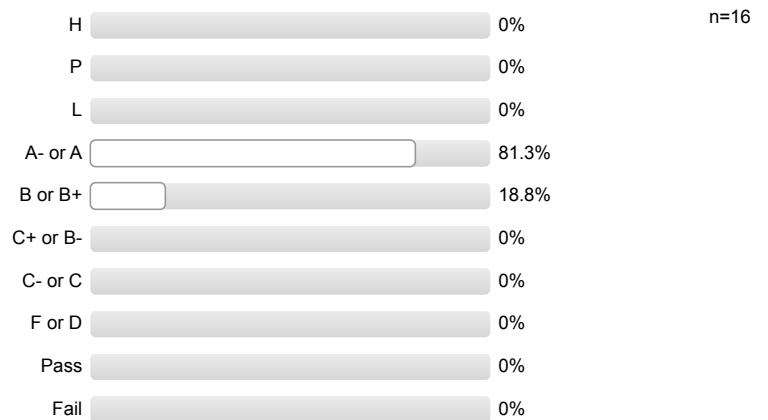


The workload was appropriate for what I gained from this class.

- I found the course material very interesting. It was something that I was unfamiliar with but I learned a lot during this semester. The skills I learned in the class are very valuable and I will use these newly learned skill in future course and after I graduate.

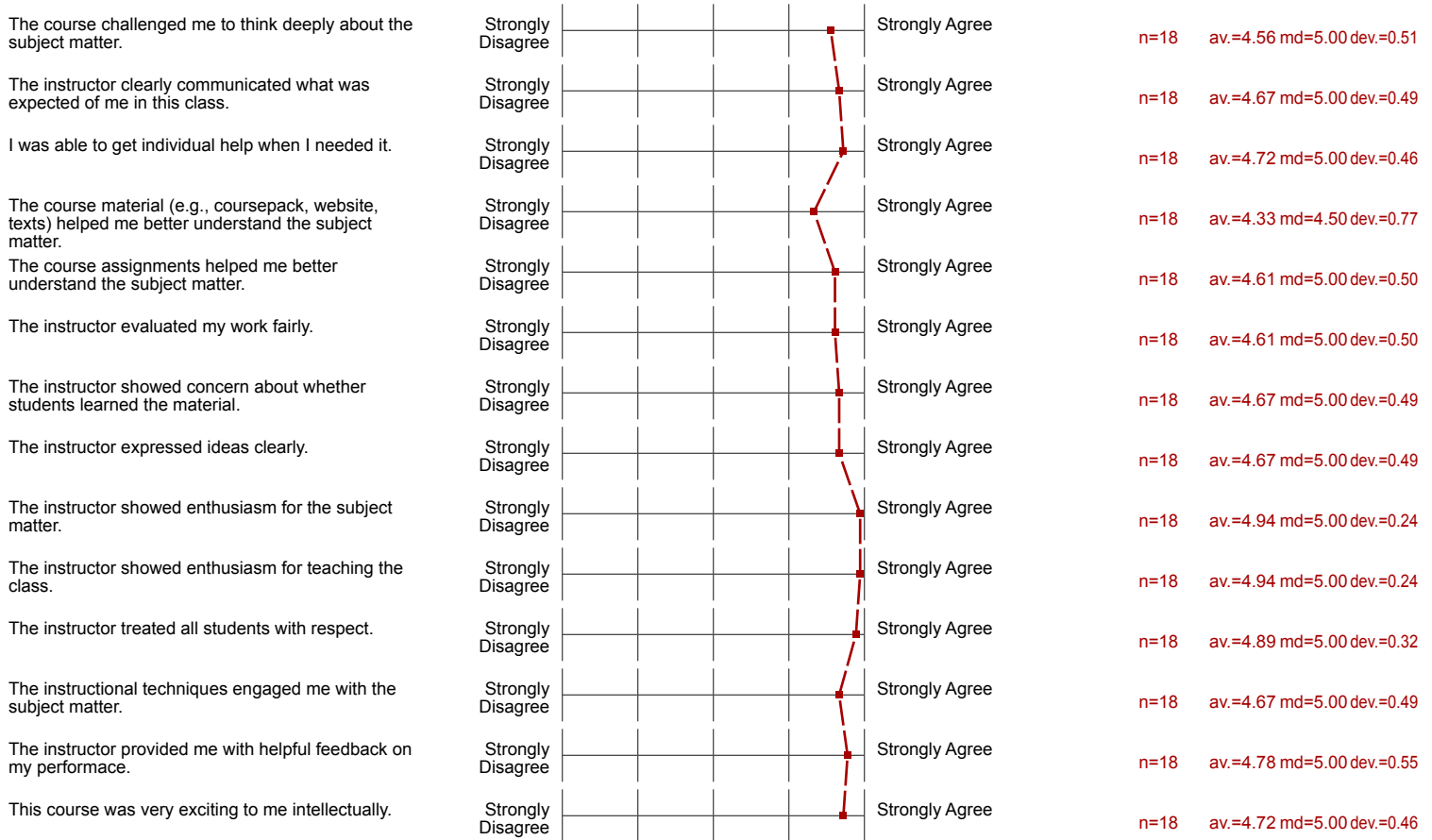
- Ben was a fantastic orator, bringing in energy and captivating us with new ideas and intellectual discussion on everything ranging from social media to the newest Batman comics and movies.

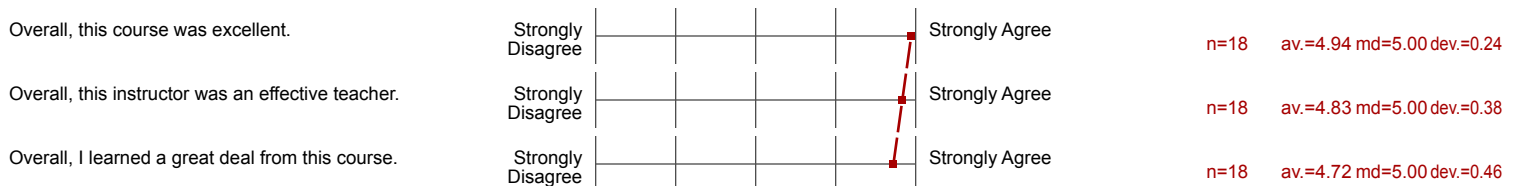
