Midterm: Podcast-Batman in the 21st Century

<u>Assignment Description:</u>

Over the first half of the semester, you will encounter a wide array of texts about Batman. For your midterm project, you and your workshop group will produce a 20-minute audio podcast in which you stage a roundtable discussion about the role of Batman in 21st-century popular culture.

A successful podcast will:

- Be uploaded directly to the course Tumblr as an mp3 file (10 MB or less) or linked to via a third-party host (such as SoundCloud) before class on **Thursday**, **February 19**th.
- Analyze the ways in which media, form, and genre have impacted the transmedia construction of the Batman mythos
- Analyze the place of *at least one* text from our course materials in the context of the Batman mythos
- Analyze the place of *at least two* texts presented by your colleagues in their Tales of the Bat video presentations in the context of the Batman mythos
- Offer opinions regarding the resilience of the Batman mythos in American popular culture
- Display proficiency in sound recording and editing tools discussed during class workshops
